



17th All Community Games 2026 Tenpin Bowling Tournament Rules & Formats

The All Community Games Bowling Tournament is organized by Sing Fai Sports Club in partnership with 900 Proshop

Eligibility

Open to all Canadian citizens and legal residents

Venue – Kennedy Bowl, 2300 Lawrence Ave E, Scarborough, ON. M1P2R3

Date: July 12, 2026 (Sunday) Registration time: 9:30 am – 10 am.

Registration of entries:

*** Deadline is on July 1, 2026. Registration will be closed before the deadline if all the available spots are filled.

(maximum of 30 teams – 120 bowlers)

All registrations are to be submitted to the All Community Games office in care of Sing Fai Sports Club. 900 Proshop will assist to collect the fee & registrations. Participants can form their own 4-person team, and doubles team at registration. The ACG tournament committee can assist to form the 4-person team and doubles team for participants registered as individuals.

Entry fee: \$60 per person + HST (13%)

Averages

- Highest average (minimum 21 games) of 2024 – 2025 Winter from GTTBA yearbook.
- If 2025 – 2026 average as of 26 Feb., 2026 is 10 pins or more than the 2024 – 2025 average with minimum 15 games, the 2025 – 2026 average will be used
- If no 2024-2025 average, current 2025-2026 average will be used with minimum 21 games
- With no valid GTTBA yearbook average, ACG will assign an average based on the average history of the bowler, otherwise the bowler will bowl scratch

Handicap

- 75% of (230 minus average)

Format:

Round 1 - 4 persons Team event, 3 games

Top 3 scores with handicap are the 1st, 2nd & 3rd places respectively.

Round 2 - Double event, 3 games

Top 3 scores with handicap are the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place respectively.

Singles event:

Top 3 scores with handicap (6 games total from Round 1 & 2) will determine the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in Singles event.

Master Championships Rounds -

For the adult division,

Top 3 Men scores with handicap (6-game total from round 1 and 2) will be seeded in Men's Adult division.

Top 3 Ladies scores with handicap (6-game total from round 1 and 2) will be seeded in Ladies Adult division.

For the senior 50+ division,

(Proof of age is required for the senior divisions)

The top 3 Senior Men scores with handicap (6-game total from round 1 and 2) will be seeded in the Senior Men's division.

The top 3 Senior Women scores with handicap (6-game total from round 1 and 2) will be seeded in the Senior Women's division.

Semi- Finals - in each division

2nd vs 3rd seed, bowl 1 game. Winners will advance to the final round.

Finals - in each division

Winners from the semi-finals vs top seed, bowl 1 game to determine the Master Champion.

Trophy and Medal Awards

Gold, Silver & Bronze medals are awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each event (4-person Team; Doubles; Singles).

Master Championships Trophy & gold medal will be awarded to the master champion in the men adult, men senior, women adult & women senior divisions. Silver medal is awarded to the 2nd place & bronze medals are awarded to the 3rd places in the Master Championships Round.

Tie breakers

When there is a tie in the 1st, 2nd & 3rd position, the earliest highest score of the 4-person team, doubles team & Single will determine the respective positions. If there is still a tie, the next highest score is adopted until the tie is broken.

Master Championships Rounds

1 ball sudden death roll-off will determine the winner.

Etiquettes

One lane courtesy is observed. Non-CTF approved powder is not allowed in bowler's area and approach. Non-bowler is not allowed in bowler's area. Headphones may only be used in between frames during competition. It must be taken off while bowling.

Unacceptable Bowler's attire per following (Dress Code)

Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriiffs, spaghetti strap tops, short shorts, track pants, jeans that are torn, not clean or in poor condition, torn tee shirts are not acceptable.

Failure to comply will be disqualified and rejected by the ACG tournament committee to bowl in the tournament.

Bowling balls

- It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the tournament are verified legally under CTF/USBC specifications. Tournament committee reserve the right to examine the balls used by the participants. Use of an illegal ball will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of games, awards and standings aside from any other penalties that may be imposed.

- Altering the surface of the bowling ball during a game is not allowed (i.e. only after completion / before commencement of each game), provided they are made at designated area and must not delay the bowler's and other's next turn / shot.

ACG adjudication

- This is a non-sanctioned tournament. However, all tournament rules published by CTF / USBC will be applied.

- ACG reserves the right to accept or refuse entry to this tournament.

- Any disputes will be settled by the ACG tournament committee

- Any appeal must be submitted in writing to ACG within 7 days after the tournament for ACG committee's review.
